THE GOLDEN Compass, Pro Evolution Soccer 2008, Sega Rally, Who Wants to be a Millionaire? 3rd Edition, Sonic Golf, Call of Duty 4: Modern Warfare and Super Breakout are the games in Glu's winter release schedule for Europe.

The Golden Compass is based on the licence from the New Line fantasy movie and Philip Pullman book of the same name.

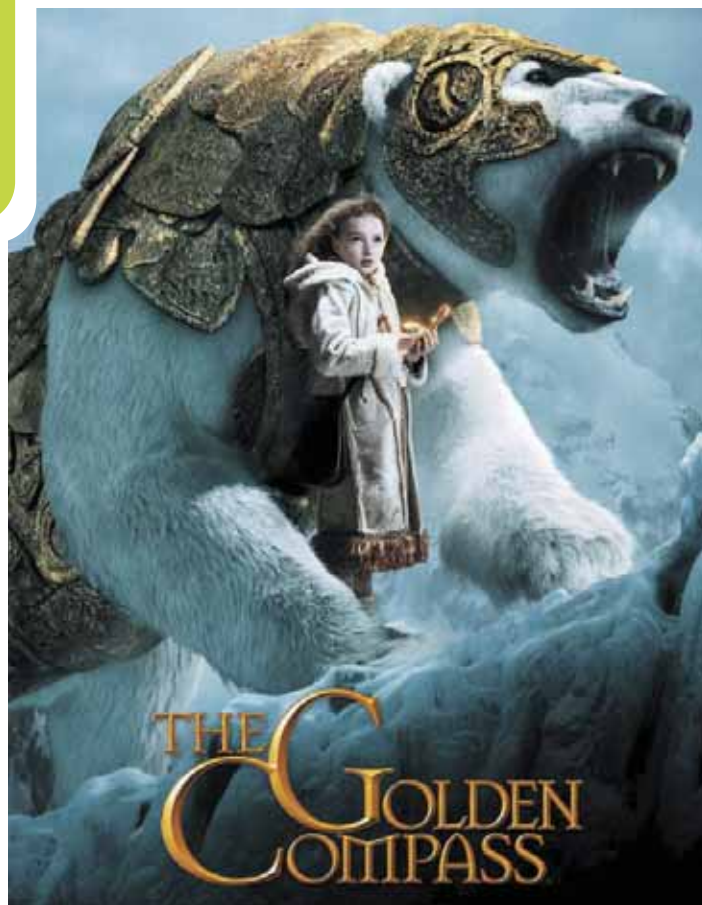
Meanwhile, long-running arcade rallying franchise Sega Rally has received the 3D treatment for mobile and Call of Duty 4 ties in with Activision's recent console release. 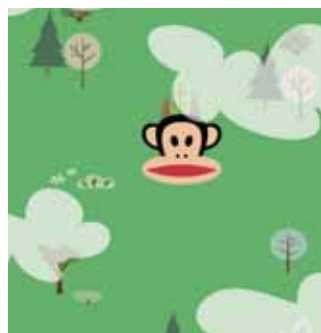


You really can't go wrong with monkeys, especially when it comes to mobile games...
